

#### NOTE FROM SR. BECKY

What does it mean to be the church? What does it mean to follow Jesus and through baptism <u>be</u> the body of Christ in the world? What does it mean to "practice resurrection?" Once we are adopted into God's family through baptism, then what? Once we "Share Christ with All", what's next for them? What's the point of congregational life? Evangelism, or inviting people into relationship with Christ is only the first step. Dwelling and maturing in that relationship is the process of formation and takes place over the rest of a person's life.

Two thousand years ago, the early church wondered about those things too. And the Apostle Paul wrote them letters of encouragement and instruction that were passed around from one congregation to the other and eventually became part of the New Testament.

This month, as we move into deep summer, we'll begin to dwell in those questions together as we hear the book of Ephesians in worship. In preparation for that I'm reading Eugene Peterson's book "Practice Resurrection: A Conversation on Growing up in Christ" where he uses the writing of St. Paul in Ephesians to examine and discuss what it means to "grow up in Christ."

These questions are not only for us as individuals but also for us as an intentional Christian community; a congregation. What does it mean for us *together* as the people of Halfway Creek Lutheran Church. I hope you'll join us and add your questions and thoughts to the conversation.

#### VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL IS COMING SOON!!


Who: Children going into preschool-5th grade
