VISION BOARD MEETING MINUTES—

Vision Board Meeting August 21, 2017

Members present include Joe Noth, Bob Bandoli, Rich Berger, Jen Strangstalien, Alex Pedretti, John Daily, Pastor Janet Wollam and Joanne Nichols. Guests present include Amy Noel and Carolyn Bjerke. Rick Johnson is absent.

President Joe Noth called the meeting to order at 6:37 pm. Pastor started the meeting with prayer.

Bob B. presented financial reports as of July 31. Net revenue is \$1,770.02. Amy questioned if the payments for Mission Support have been made monthly. Bob said it is paid a month behind. John D. motioned to accept the treasurers financial report as presented with the expectation that the income amounts will be reconciled to the financial secretary's giving report. Rich B. seconded the motion. Motion approved.

Carolyn B. said she is still by title the bookkeeper. Amy N. questions this because the Board hired and approved a financial assistant to do the bookkeeping.


Current bank signers on the general fund bank account are Bob B., Carolyn B, Rhonda Britton and Josh Johnson. Carolyn said Treasurer and President can sign contracts. They should not also be allowed to sign the checks because they would have complete control. John said he's okay with a second signer, that's not the issue it's the transparency. John motioned for Bob B and Rich B to be the only signers on the bank accounts except for the youth account. Alex P. seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Pastor contacted Ken Morrison, CPA of Morrison & Associates regarding an audit of the financials. He has offered to do an audit of the books for \$100 per hour. This is a \$60 per hour discount. Bob B. will contact the audit firm to set up the audit for this fall.

Carolyn B. reported Festival Foods is going to be issuing gift cards thru the Great Lakes Program instead of directly from their stores.

John D. motioned to approve the minutes for the July 27 meeting. Jen S. seconded the motion. Motion passed.

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Holmen's Hope started a Friday backpack program and needs our congregations' help. As we know many children in our community are on free and reduced lunches in our local schools. We believe some of these children may go hungry on the weekends when meals are unavailable.

On Fridays, Holmen's Hope fills backpacks with non-perishable or microwaveable meals/snacks children can take home and delivers them to schools. The children return the backpacks on Monday and Holmen's Hope refills them weekly. The school principals and guidance counsellors have been the ones selecting the students/families they feel have the most need.

Here is the list of items Holmen's Hope is asking our congregations to donate for backpacks. Items can be brought to the Beer & Hymn Sing or dropped off at any Halfway Creek Lutheran Church or Coulee Life Church during the week.



Amy N. reported this Sunday, will be an organizational meeting of the Stewardship Team. There will be various communications to the congregation leading up to the Celebration Luncheon. Jazzercise has been using the church for free for twice weekly classes for over a year now. Pastor suggested we consider requesting a donation to cover some of the janitorial and utility costs.

A motion was made by John D. and seconded by Jen S. to adjourn. Motion passed.

The meeting was closed with the Lord's Prayer.

During the month of October, we will celebrate the 500th Anniversary of the Reformation with the following events:



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Consecration Sunday Is Coming!!

Congregations that approach financial stewardship from a biblical perspective do not view the money Christians give to their church merely as a way to pay its bills. Rather, such congregations see financial contributions as a way to help people grow spiritually in their relationship with God by supporting their church's mission and ministry with a percentage of their incomes.

Our congregation's Stewardship Team has selected the *New Consecration* Sunday Stewardship Program as a way to teach the biblical and spiritual principles of generous giving in our stewardship education emphasis this year.

New Consecration Sunday is based on the biblical philosophy of the need of the giver to give for his or her own spiritual development, rather than on the need of the church to receive. Instead of treating people like members of a social club who should pay dues, we will treat people like followers of Jesus Christ who want to give unselfishly as an act of discipleship. New Consecration Sunday encourages people toward proportionate and systematic giving in response to the question, "What percentage of my income is God calling me to give?"

During morning worship on Consecration Sunday, we are asking our attendees and members to make their financial commitments to our church's missionary, benevolent, and educational ministries in this community and around the world. Please note that we will have only **ONE SERVICE at 10:00 a.m. on Sunday, November 12th.**

Every attendee and member who completes an *Estimate of Giving Card* does so voluntarily by attending morning worship on Consecration Sunday. We urge people to attend who feel strongly opposed to completing a card. The procedure is done in such a way that no one feels personal embarrassment if he or she chooses not to fill out a card.

We will do no home solicitation to ask people to complete cards. During morning worship our guest leader will conduct a brief period of instruction and inspiration, culminating in members making their commitments as a confidential act of worship.

We will encourage participation in Consecration Sunday events through the Consecration Sunday team and Vision board members. Since we will make no follow-up visits to ask people to complete their cards, we will make every effort to inform, inspire, and commit everyone to attend Consecration Sunday worship.
