NO Bible Study for December. See you back on Thursday, January 18th. We will be going through Chapter 7 & 8.



STEWARDSHIP UPDATE

A very successful Consecration Sunday event was held on November 12,2017. Pastor Dave Bersagel was the event leader. He shared a very powerful message on being a generous giver. We served approximately 120 guests at our celebration meal. Thank you to L & M Catering of Melrose for their delicious meal.

The following show the results of our efforts.

- 1. 49 giving units completed an estimate of giving card on Consecration Sunday.
- 2. A total of 31 of these giving units increased their financial commitment above their last year's amount.
- 3. A total of 37 giving units filled out estimate of giving cards and committed a total of \$94,068.
- 4. Based on last's year's giving records, we can expect to receive \$47,896 during the coming year from people who have consistent giving patterns during the past 12 months but were not present on Consecration Sunday.
- 5. Based on the average total of loose offerings during the past three years, we can expect to receive \$4240 during the coming year from that source.
- 6. This gives us a grand total of \$146,204 anticipated income for the next twelve months.
- 8. The total income for our general operating budget during the last 12 months was \$164,681
- 9. **What's ahead ?** Estimate of giving cards went out to all giving units of the congregation who were not in attendance at the Consecration Sunday event. We did have a positive response to that mailing last year. Please take the time to complete the card and return it in the self addressed and stamped envelope.

Halfway Creek continues to be very generous in their giving.

VISION BOARD MEETING MINUTES-OCTOBER 19, 2017

Members present include Joe Noth, Bob Bandoli, Jen Strangstalien, John Daily. Joanne Nichols and Rich Berger were excused.

President Joe Noth called the meeting to order at 7:00. Joe led devotion talking about Martin Luther's 95 thesis and the 95 "visions" for HCLC.

Bob made a motion to approve the minutes with noted minor wording. John seconded. Carried unanimously.

Amy Noel reported her progress on updating the HCLC constitution and the changes in the ELCA model constitution since the last update. Three changes stand out since the constitution was update last time. One change to the model constitution has provisions for deacon and deaconess involvement in congregations as ministers of "Word and Service" as compared to pastors as ministers of "Word and Sacrament." Another provision applies to 2 point or more parish's. We are not sure if these provisions apply to HCLC. The third change is clarification of "seasonal members." Amy will continue to work on the constitution.

Amy also brought forward a draft job description changes for the Director of Music Ministries. The Vision Board reviewed the changes. John made a motion to approve the job description as presented. Bob seconded the motion. Carried unanimously.

The Vision board thanked Amy for her hard work on the constitution and with the personnel team.

Jen reported the confirmation class has met a couple of times. Jen, Joanne and Ruth Jostad are leading the confirmation students this year. So far we have 24 students participating. They will have a lock in on November 3. They are focusing on the 10 commandments this year. Sunday School has started with good participation. Sunday school will sing at the 10:30 service at the end of the month.

The Vision Board talked about the nomination process for the vision board in 2018. We will use a similar process as we did last year. Last year we asked the congregation to make nominations of people they feel would make good board members. Those nominated were asked to prayerfully consider their gifts and talents. There are several positions open on the Vision Board now. Bob's term as treasurer will end this year.

Bob gave the treasurers report. The general fund balance is \$2,135.23. The board would encourage congregation members to use "Simply Giving" for their offering. Bob reported that Jodi is doing an awesome job as bookkeeper. The treasurers work will be much more simplified for the next treasurer. Bob reported Ken Morrison looked at our accounting processes and called them "rock solid." The only concern was to make sure we have 2 counters work on the offering together after services. We have had times with only one. Jen made a motion to accept the treasurers report. John seconded. Carried unanimously.

The board talked about records retention policy. Decided to table the issue until we have a pastor serving the church.

We have had some new member requests. The Vision Board will be working to install new members as requested.

Rose has received a request from Pastor Wollam for copies of Vision Board minutes between February and June of 2017. The minutes should be available on our website. The Vision Board instructed Joe to let Rose know she could send the minutes to Pastor Wollam.

John made a motion to adjourn at 7:52. Bob second. Carried unanimously.
