#### **HAPPENINGS AT HCLC**

### **Congregation Conversation—Sunday, July 14th**

The Vision Board has continued to evaluate and discuss the financial health of HCLC. We are inviting you to join in the discussion and decision making at a congregational conversation on Sunday, July 14th at 10:00 am.

### Your Worship Team—Sunday, July 28th

The Halfway Creek Lutheran Worship Team was formed more than 15 years ago. Our mission is to enhance the worship experience through music. To expose and teach new, often contemporary music, to the congregation and to lead a less traditional style of worship service. During much of this time, we experience growth in worship attendance. For this reason, we decided several years ago to utilize the choir loft space for the Worship Team. The move would allow more seating in the sanctuary. In addition, moving the sound equipment allowed us to remove the trip hazard that existed with the sound equipment cords.

What we did not anticipate, was the loss of engagement with the congregation. It is difficult, if not impossible, to see the team in the loft and it is difficult for the team to see the congregation. The Worship Team would like to move back to the main floor of the sanctuary. We would move in front of the organ where we were stationed for so many years. The cords can be brought in from the loft to eliminate the trip hazard. We are asking for feedback on this proposed change. We ask you to talk to Worship Team members and let them know what you think. If you would like us to move back down to the floor, let us know. If you have any concerns about the change, let us know about that as well.

Many people have been involved with the Worship Team over the years. One of our greatest joys has been "worshiping well." The mixture of contemporary songs and traditional hymns resulted in a blended service that most seemed to enjoy. Much of the positive energy we received while leading music, came from the congregation. We miss that engagement.

The Worship Team has taken some time off this summer. Our first service will be on July 28. We would like to be on the main floor by then. Please let us know your thoughts before July 28. 


## **Commissioning Youth**

### Financial Report Update from Q & A on June 16, 2019

Thanks to everyone who gave generously in early June to assist us with meeting immediate expenses.

In November 2018, we withdrew \$8,000 from our Thrivent fund to cover expenses. Year to date \$4,492 has been paid back with a remaining \$3,508 to be paid back. Let's please keep it going. Please reference contributions with Repay Thrivent Fund.

When the Thrivent Fund was opened there was a Trust Foundation document created to provide oversight of the funds. The Vision Board is looking for an individual(s) that has expertise in this area to provide feedback on the document. If interested please contact Rose in the church office.

Our dedicated funds have been paid back in full from the money that was borrowed in 2018 to cover expenses.

Each Sunday following the monthly Vision Board meeting we are reviewing the prior month and year to date financials. During the summer months we will meet after service.

Approval of Agenda- Motion to approve by Ruth, Gaye made the second, motion passed.

Approval of April 2019 Minutes- Motion to approve minutes with minor changes made by Mike, second by Ruth- Motion Passed

Ministry Report- Motion to receive the Ministry report made by Gaye, John seconded- Motion passed.

Financial Report-

April 2019 Total Revenue: \$20,911.14; Total Expenditures: \$21,014.82

YTD Revenue: \$125,131.37; YTD \$75,720.86

It looks like financially we are ahead but that is due to the contributions to payback our Thrivent fund and dedicated funds. We are making good headway in paying those back. Jodi talked Todd Trautman about the trust fund, they reviewed the paperwork and but the board never was developed. Should reach out to the congregation to see if there is anyone that that has a talent for financial background to help guide us.

Discussion on putting together the capital fundraiser.

We will meet for the financial discussion on Sunday morning in between services, 5/12/19..

Motion to approve the financial report made by Gaye, seconded by Mike- Motion Passed

**Old Business** 

Ministry Teams- Meeting held Tuesday 5/7/19. Kathi Hagel will type up a report and bring to June Meeting. We had at least 1 person from each team except the Property team. Good discussion happened and was a good start.

Principle Reduction Drive-

Brat Barn- Ruth took out a Thrivent Action plan- we are not using the Brat Barn for the principle reduction but for our mission outside the church, like buying socks and underwear for the homeless, the lunch backpack program... Sign up push on May 19<sup>th</sup>.

Do we want to do a debt reduction/general fund focus? We want to be able to support our teams and mission.

- We continue to discuss, but at this time we do not feel we want to do debt reduction/or principle reduction drive. We will need to think about doing one with in the next 2 years. But we will continue to encourage the support of debt reduction and funding our general fund so we can support our ministries
- Stewardship for All Seasons- Amy is meeting with the Stewardship meeting this month. The synod did not get as much grant money as they had hoped, which would of subsidized the payment for us.
- Sanctuary Roof John Daily will discuss with Archie to see when the roof actually needs to be done this year.

#### **New Business**

- Meeting with the Bishop Candidacy committee meeting is August 15<sup>th</sup>, following the approval of the candidacy committee, we can call a congregational meeting to vote on calling Sister Becky. We need to call the meeting at least 2 weeks in advance. Jen might be meeting with the Bishop again prior to August to get more details.
- Space Planning- Discussion of changing the coffee area. Not a good time to do it, but possibly a long term goal. But good to get the information out there. The thought is to make the area more hospitable and accessible. Invite the discussion.
