READING: Matthew 1:18-24

Now the birth of Jesus, the Messiah, took place this way. When his mother Mary had been engaged to Joseph, but before they lived together, she was found to be with child from the Holy Spirit. Her husband Joseph, being a righteous man, not willing to expose her to public disgrace, planned to dismiss her quietly. But just when he had resolved to do this, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream and said, "Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary as your wife, for the child conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit. She will bear a son and you are to name him Jesus for he will save his people from their sins." All this took place to fulfill what had been spoken by the Lord through the prophet: "Look, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son and they shall name him Emmanuel" which means "God is with us." And when Joseph awoke from sleep he did as the angel of the Lord commanded him. He took her as his wife.



Christmas Eve Worship & RSVP

The seasons of Advent and Christmas are quickly approaching! Planning a Christmas worship schedule during a time of rising COVID cases has provided another year of worship planning challenges for the Music and Liturgy team.

With much consideration, the Music and Liturgy team has decided to offer two 30-minute Christmas Eve worship services: one at 2 pm and one at 3:30 pm. In order to do our part in protecting the most vulnerable among us, we will require masks, allow for physical distance in the pews, use sanitizer, take communion at our seats, and sanitize the pews in between services. In addition, we are limiting seating in the sanctuary to 50 people per each service.

WE NEED YOUR HELP! WE ARE ASKING YOU TO RESERVE YOUR SPOT FOR CHRISTMAS EVE WORSHIP, FIRST-COME, FIRST SERVE BY NO LATER THAN SUNDAY, DECEMBER 12TH. If both services fill up, we will add a 3rd service at 4:30 pm, and we need time to find worship volunteers and communicate an addition to the planned worship schedule.
