

Reach Out, Share Christ with All

From Pastor Chris

In February our worship texts continue to follow Jesus' life and ministry in John's gospel. During this month, as we look forward to Lent, we hear in the stories Jesus' invitation to abundant life.

Jesus' ministry continues as he calls those around him into new life. Each interaction reveals more about Jesus' identity and the promises of God, as well as God's desire for all to know abundant life. From invitations to be born anew through the Spirit, to promises of living water, these encounters with Jesus leave the individuals changed and further illustrate Jesus' purpose and ministry of bringing life to all.

As we walk through John's gospel the stories we experience are: John 4:1-42 - The woman at the well: Jesus broke down barriers throughout his ministry.

John 4:46-54 and 5:1-18 - Healing stories: Jesus healed many people, not just their bodies, but in all areas of wellness.

John 6:35-59 - Jesus proclaimed that he is "the bread of life." Although people had trouble understanding, Jesus' invitation is clear: He is the bread of life and we are invited to partake.

John 7:37-52 - Jesus said, "Out of the believer's heart shall flow rivers of living water." Jesus is that living water and he invites, "Let anyone who is thirsty come to me."

John 9:1-41 - Jesus challenged the Pharisees' beliefs, inviting them - and us - to grow in faith and understanding.

Invitation is a fitting theme to prelude the season of Lent. As we hear the message of Jesus beckon us to come and see, to come and experience, to come and enter into this walk with him, let us get ready to heed that invitation as we begin our Lenten journeys.

Jesus and his message bring abundant life to those most in need of it. That might happen for you as you engage in a Lenten discipline, or take part in a study. God's word works on us internally as we gather together with other followers around the scriptures and hear again the stories of Jesus' life and work, his death and resurrection. God's word also works through us in the world as we rise to meet the challenges of life each day. It takes root in the world as God's people live out the gospel in action and policy to make abundant life a reality for all people around us.

This month my prayer for you is that you find from God's Word an invitation to abundant life – an invitation to experience God's love for yourself and those around you; May you find the invitation to see that you are loved; the invitation to see yourself as a precious child of God, just as you are; the invitation to see that you are worthy of love and respect; the invitation to see that you are capable of making a positive difference in the world; and the invitation to experience that all as you walk with Jesus.

May you live out your faith vibrantly this season, working toward abundant life for all those around you, and knowing the love of Christ in your life.






