


OFFERING PROJECT

We have great ministry that happens here at HCLC. That takes commitment of many sorts from showing up to volunteering to offering and other generous gifts. The great news is that we are so close to doing a very good job of funding our ministry as we head toward summer. The bad news is that we have been \$600-800 short each month. That has started to leave our checkbook inadequate at times.

But more good news!! We came up with a visual representation of what a fully funded budget looks like, and what that means is something very small - and now it leads to a fun party!



With just an increase between of \$10-20 per week from each of you already giving, we would make that shortfall go away (yay!). So, we are collecting anonymous commitments to increase $\frac{1}{4}$ step (\$2.50 – \$5, depending on your current level), $\frac{1}{2}$ step (\$5-10), 1 step (\$10 -20) or more! When we "collect" 45 steps worth of increase...we are throwing a party!

So next time you're in church, grab one of these "stairway to giving" cards and tell us (again, anonymously) that you are committing to giving even just \$2.50 (or \$5 or \$10!) more each week by writing how many portions of "stairs" you are increasing.

Let's celebrate a fully funded budget, and the generosity God has shown us to fulfil the mission God has for us here!
