FROM PASTOR CHRIS

This month I am reflecting on the marking of my five-year anniversary of ordination. I am so thrilled to be celebrating my first "milestone" anniversary of ordination while I am here at HCLC with all of you!

My ordination service was held just down the road, at Holmen Lutheran on June 27, 2017 before I started my first call a pastor in Rice Lake, WI. It was an honor to have my seminary professor Dr. Craig Nessan preaching. At that time, I had done a poor job of imagining how to celebrate the occasion for myself and so gave him the most awful text to preach on for an ordination. But he, of course, did spectacularly. It was very cool to see people there from the various stages of my life - my home congregation, seminary, internship, and verysoon-to-be first call.

It is important to mark occasions or milestones in our life. In our life together at church we have many ways of marking some of these. For instance, we hold worship around baptisms, confirmations, weddings, funerals, etc. We have blessings and rites for the starting of school years, hunting seasons, receiving Bibles, first communion and more. It is a big part of what we do as church to mark these major points in our lives and remember the presence of Jesus with us - to remember the belonging we have in his name because of his love for us and the calling we have to share his love in the next phase of our lives.

This upcoming program year at church we will be centering our energy around the milestones of faith. Our Sunday school program will be especially illustrious of this. As the young people of our congregation grow into the promises we made for them at baptism living among God's faithful people, hearing the Word of God and sharing the Lord's supper, learning the Lord's prayer, creed, and 10 commandments, getting the Holy Scriptures placed in their hands - each grade will have special days in worship where they, and their faith journey, will be celebrated.
