SUNDAY SCHOOL NEWS

Sunday School - Milestones:

This year, one of biggest Sunday School focuses will be on walking with one another through the milestones of our faith.

As the young people of our congregation grow into the promises we made for them at baptism each grade will have special days in worship where they, and their faith journey, will be celebrated.

Those promises, remember, are:

- living among God's faithful people,
- hearing the Word of God and sharing the Lord's supper,
- learning the Lord's prayer, creed, and 10 commandments,
- getting the Holy Scriptures placed in their hands

Six milestone lessons throughout the year will bring families together during the Sunday school hour for pastor-led, family-focused lessons around these promises. In church these will be lived out – students will receive their Bible, help serve communion, lead the Lord's Prayer, lead the Creed, proclaim the promise of baptism, and help us celebrate the ten commandments.

Welcome to 6th Graders and welcome back to all our confirmation students this fall!


