FROM PASTOR CHRIS

As we embark on this season of Lent, we are readying ourselves to ponder the immensity that is holy week. We are readying our hearts and minds to experience the joy and mystery of the Easter story. We are preparing ourselves to take up again and anew the call that comes with being Jesus' people - people who follow him to the cross and come victorious, and changed, through that cross to new life.

For us at HCLC this year that means we are spending each week pondering the final words of Jesus from the cross. Those words, even for as few as they are, are like a final sermon that points back to his whole life and all his teaching, These words become one more final way Jesus teaches his followers, all who are watching, and us today reading this amazing story, what it is he is doing in bringing God's kingdom to the world.

At our worship on Wednesdays we will spend time in fellowship and conversation around a meal, and see a video resource from Adam Hamilton that goes along with his book, <u>Final Words from the Cross</u> (Abingdon Press, 2011). We also will be using coloring pages for prayer and meditation from *IllustratedMinistry*, which also comes with a devotion to spark more conversation.

• Cremation urns may be buried in an existing family member's plot (a parent, grandparent, great-grandparent, aunt or uncle, for example) for \$250 per urn.
