President's Letter

Greetings to all ladies in the La Crosse Area Synod!

Crosswinds is back! Hallelujah! Thanks be to God! Read it, enjoy, and respond!

Within the pages of this issue of Crosswinds you'll see the results of this year's mission work reflecting some of the numerous ways we care for our neighbors with the making of: quilts, health kits, personal care kits, baby kits and sewing kits. Additionally, meals are served, food pantries are manned, cookies are baked, and people are clothed; and the list goes on and on. THANK YOU for all the acts of kindness, compassion, and generosity you exhibit on a daily basis. I'm reminded of a Bing Crosby song that concludes, "It's not the things you do at Christmas time, but the Christmas things you do all year through." Women of the ELCA personify "God's work; our hands."

We'd like to thank everyone who attended Fall Renewal on Oct. 15 at First Lutheran in Onalaska. If you weren't there, you missed an amazing day. Though we muddled through some early glitches and had last minute changes (lunch in the narthex instead of downstairs), the day progressed with nary a hiccup. Many thanks to the ladies on the board who worked diligently to bring you the best we could offer. Here's what you missed.

Pastor Karyn Bodenschatz began our day with an interactive devotion which helped set the tone for the day: communicate and let the Spirit guide us. The ladies at First Lutheran were gracious, welcoming, and very hospitable, serving up a scrumptious luncheon.

Isaiah Thomas and Willow Pecha from the Salvation Army reminded us of the many good works performed across various spectrums of society by the army of volunteers and professionals ready to assist people in their time of need. Isaiah reminded us that the average Salvation Army organization score on Charity Navigator is 87%, which means that 87% of the money it receives goes directly into programs to benefit the needy. That is an awesome score!

Equally motivating was our afternoon speaker, Alice Holstein, who took us on the journey of her life, remarkable in its convoluted pathways and exceptional in its complexity. She led us from the halls of academia to the alleys of homelessness, mental illness, prison, and slowly into recovery. The standing ovation she received as she concluded her presentation was testament to her affect on the audience; she is a rock star in overcoming adversity. We thank her so much for sharing her story with us.

Sandwiched between those outstanding speakers was an update by Krishna Battista on the progress of Family Promise of Monroe County, whose mission is to help children and their families achieve sustainable independence. In December 2021, Tia Hewuse, a new executive director was hired; a Day Center was opened

in June of 2022, and a case worker, Jesse Todd, came on board in September. (February up-date: Tia has resigned, Jesse has become the executive director, and a new office administrator has been hired. Two families are currently in the program.) Within this structure, Family Promise is able to more efficiently attack homelessness in Monroe County.

During our group meetings, everyone seemed to enjoy the opportunity to share exciting, (and sometimes not so exciting) things that are going on at their churches. The theme of "building back" was in the air as congregations struggle to welcome people and programs back into existence after two years of covid-19 seclusion. Resilience, creativity, and persistence are just some of the characteristics being utilized by area WELCAs. "Show me your ways, O God. Guide me in your truth and teach me," Psalm 25: 4-5. Ladies agreed that more time for conversations was needed!

Our Fall Renewal hosted 50 women, which was wonderful considering that 12 days before we had zero! Mark your calendars because on **April 29, 2023**, we will convene our **Spring Convention** at Blair Lutheran in Blair. Encourage ladies in your churches and community (WE WELCOME ALL!) to give themselves a present: a day of relaxation, education, good food, and fellowship. We want YOU to be there!

Also, within your WELCA groups please discuss the possibility of your church hosting an upcoming event. We currently need a Fall Renewal host, and of course locations for our two gatherings in 2024 as well. Let's look to the future! God is calling us, and it's up to us to answer that call. I'd be happy to answer any questions! 608-269-2325

The mission of Crosswinds is to communicate and educate. Spring Convention In-Kind Offering

Our In-Kind Offering for this year's Spring Convention will go to the Salvation Army.

One of our keynote speakers at the Spring Convention will be Pastor Joanne Richmond. Pastor Joanne, who is the pastor at Ours Saviors in La Crosse and is part of the Synod's Church in Society Committee, will be discussing "Being Lutheran and Being a Citizen."

Summary: Pastor Joanne will address the relationship between faith and citizenship, as lived by Lutherans in the United States. This relationship between faith and nation, church and state, exists in each of us while simultaneously being lived "out" in our daily lives. Current societal pressures, coming from all facets of political and religious life, confuse our thinking about faith and nation, church and state.

The purpose of this presentation: to engage in a conversation about citizenship in the context of Lutheran thought, most specifically a Lutheran understanding of baptism, with the hope of relieving any confusion we experience as we live as both baptized children of God and citizens.

BOARD OF THE SYNOD WOMEN'S ORGANIZATION

There shall be a board of this synod women's organization consisting of four elected officers together with five elected members, four members elected from the territory of each conference and one elected at large. All board members shall be participants in a congregational unit and members of the ELCA.

Members of the board shall be elected by the convention for a term of two years with one consecutive re-election and may not serve on the board in any capacity for more than seven consecutive years.

The board shall be legislative authority between conventions of this synod women's organizations and shall carry forward the work of the synod women's organization, act for it and report its actions to subsequent conventions.

Board members shall attend all board meetings and all meetings of committees to which they have been assigned. They shall read and become familiar with all board and committee mailings prior to the meetings and be familiar with the budget. Board members shall attend synod conventions and workshops and shall perform the duties as assigned by the president or executive board.

Nominees are needed for the offices of President, Treasurer, North Conference Representative, and South Conference Representative for full two-year terms. A West Conference Representative is needed to fill a one-year term. Elections will be held at the Spring Convention on April 29, 2023.

LA CROSSE AREA SYNOD W-ELCA NOMINATION FORM FOR SYNOD BOARD

Nominees are needed for the offices of President, Treasurer, North Conference Representative, and South Conference Representative, for full two-year terms. Nominees are needed for the office of West Conference Representative for a partial one-year term. Elections will be held at Spring Convention on April 29, 2023. THE PRESIDENT SHALL

- 1. Preside at all conventions of the synod women's organization and at meetings of the board and administrative committee;
- 2. Ensure that the constitution and bylaws of the synod women's organization are duly observed and that the actions thereof are carried into effect, and appoint all committees not otherwise provided for;
- 3. Be an ex-officio member of all committees of the synod women's organization except the Nominating Committee;
- 4. Submit a report to each regular convention of the synod women's organization concerning her work, with observation and recommendations affecting the synod women's organization as she may deem important;
- 5. Serve as liaison with churchwide women's organization and attend the meetings of the Conference of Synod Presidents;
- 6. Represent the synod women's organization at or appoint representatives to inter-Lutheran and ecumenical associations and councils in which the organization participates; and
- 7. Serve as representative to the Synod Council, or appoint a representative.
- 8. Two-year term with one (1) re-election

THE TREASURER SHALL

- 1. Provide for the keeping of all records and be accountable for all funds;
- 2. Be responsible for disbursing funds in accordance with the financial policies of Women of the ELCA and the budget of the synod women's organizations;
- 3. Present a complete report, including an audit, to the synod women's organization convention and an interim report to each board and administrative committee meeting;
- 4. Attend Synod Women's Board meetings as a voting member; as well as Spring Convention and Fall Renewal;
- 5. Two-year term with one (1) re-election

THE CONFERENCE REPRESENTATIVES SHALL

- 1. Act as presiding officer of the Conference Committee
- 2. Attend Synod Women's Board meetings as a non-voting member. Four meetings per year held in La Crosse.
- 3. Act as a liaison between the individual units and the Synod Women's Board.
- 4. Work with the Synod Women's Board and Conference Committee to plan the Fall Renewal.
- 5. Plan with the Conference Committee, a special event for conference members. Conference programs could include retreats, a Bible study, a day trip, etc.
- 6. Insure any necessary business of the conference is conducted at the Fall Renewal and/or special event.
- 7. Submit articles to the synod newsletter, "Crosswinds" as appropriate.
- 8. Chair the nominating committee for conference officers.
- 9. Compile a notebook of minutes and events to give to your successor at the transition meeting.
- 10. Two year term with one (1) re-election.

The following information is from the W-ELCA Churchwide in Chicago.

WHAT IS AN ACTIVE UNIT?

A unit must commit to four items in order to be recognized as active:

- 1. Come together for study, support, and action.
- 2. Participate in the ministry of W-ELCA beyond the congregation.
- 3. Support financially the total program of W-ELCA.
- 4. Designate leadership that shall be in communication with the synodical and Churchwide women's organization.


