Call to Order @ 6PM

<u>Approval of Agenda</u> - Motion made and seconded to approve agenda. Motion carried. <u>Devotion/Prayer</u> - Bette

Actions since last meeting: Approved 9/23/25 VB minutes via email.

Financial Report:

- We received the report with a review of the financials by Jodi.
- Noisy Offering: October: Breast Cancer we will split the proceeds between Mayo and Gundersen to accounts that directly support patients. November: Star Center The **STAR Center** helps all **La Crosse**-area community members live their best lives through adaptive fitness programming, wheelchair sports and more. We have congregational members directly involved in this program. December: ELCA Good Gifts along with ornaments on the tree.
- Discussed noisy offering schedule for upcoming year and inviting speakers to talk about their program.
- Thrivent Maintenance account will be set up next week.

<u>Ministry/Office Update:</u> SAMs report - Patti reviewed her activity during the month of September and responded to questions.

<u>Music and Liturgy:</u> Sound System update - new sound board and microphones are being used. We are hoping to raise enough money for a key board. Recommend: Communication update (newsletter and email) about progress and what we still hope to raise.

Old Business:

- Tech Team All upgrades working well.
- Property Team Outside door by old office is in process of being installed. Still waiting on parsonage patio door. Winterized stain glass windows in worship area. Checking to see if choir loft still needs to be done.
- Outreach Wayne working on more durable outside signage for November 17, 2025 Blood Drive.

- Legacy Committee Has invited the congregation into conversation during the fellowship hour on Oct. 12 and 19 to answer questions and get input.
- Safety plan/policies:
 - 1. Update from walk-through with LaX Cty Sgt. Kevin Bauer. He can offer several opportunities for education and preparedness.
 - 2. La Crosse Area Security Network involving several area churches, extended an invitation for Nov. 1, starting with a light breakfast at 8 and then meeting from 8:30 to 10 at North Side Community Church. Please let Michelle or Bette know if you are interested in attending.

New Business:

- La Crosse Area Synod RIC Discernment Bette asked us to review the La Crosse Area Synod RIC (Reconciling in Christ) Discernment document (dated 8/8/25) and asked us to begin to think about how we have this conversation with the congregation in the future.
- Six-month review of Patti and the SAM (Synod Authorized Minister) role at HCLC using the yearly review input form recently introduced by the Synod. Next steps:
 - 1. Amy will write up the responses from our conversation.
 - 2. Patti is also completing this form.
 - 3. Bette and Amy will meet with Patti and establish goals for the coming year and then share with Vision Board
