I would also like to extend a thank you to Dan Brudahl, Mark Witte, Bill Achterkirch, Jr., and La Verne Paulson for additional grounds clean-up and tree and stump removal that was done. I heard many compliments throughout the season about how nice the cemetery looked.

I would also like to thank Ruth Scholze for assisting with correspondence and promotion throughout the year and Dan Brudahl for his dedicated work as Treasurer over the last six years. I'm grateful to Kent Kramer for being willing to step into the role. Lastly, I would like to thank all those who gave memorials to the cemetery throughout the year. They are greatly appreciated.

Digital mapping of the cemetery remains an ongoing project. It has largely been completed for the Middle and New Sections of the cemetery but still needs to be done for the Old Section closest to the creek.

Looking ahead, the Trustees will be exploring options for temporary burial markers to better mark gravesites until a monument can be placed and creating a space at the back of the New Section of the cemetery near the dirt pile where vehicles can turn around.
